## Description

To look at climate change from a different perspective, the Business Sustainability Council met in a series of workshops that have resulted in a practical guide on managing climate risks in businesses. In the context of sustainability, it is essential to understand and also assess the impact of future climate risks on the company's operations, not only business contribution and compliance with climate targets. In the transition to a climate-neutral economy, it is especially important for industries responsible for the largest share of greenhouse gas emissions, energy and water consumption to adjust their strategies.
