The EduFire Toolkit project develops a set of multidisciplinary educational resources following a Project Based Learning. It includes activities aimed at promoting community engagement in wildfire prevention efforts. The Edufire Toolkit platform provides open educational resources, namely two modules with nine units, covering topics like fire history and ecology, wildfire behaviour, management, prevention, and adaptation.

Students engage in hands-on challenges, supported by the following resources: video, teachers guide, and collaborative map. Tests using tools like forms assess students' understanding before and after the program.
