This Quiz has been designed for children in the 3rd cycle (CM1-CM2-6ème). It is also available to parents and teachers. This 24-question quiz tests children's knowledge of forest/vegetation fires and the associated risks.

Relevance to CRISEPAC Objectives

This activity is part of the CRISEPAC project, which enables students to learn about wildfire and how to behave or even protect against it.
